Dear Members:

The 99th annual show and sale will be held June 29, 2018 and June 30, 2018 at the Hill Country Exhibition Center (Show Barn) in Kerrville, Texas.

The judge for **all white goats** will be Paul Grafe. Show and sale goats need to be in place no later than 9:00 am on Friday, June 29, 2018. We will begin with show goats promptly at 9:00 a.m.. You may bring your goats in on Thursday after 1:00 to 6:00 p.m. The sale goats will be judged after the show goats. The annual meeting will be held after all goats have been judged on Friday.

This year the **colored goats** will be judged on Saturday morning at 8:00 a.m.. In addition to the TAGRA colored angora goat show, we will be hosting the ACAGR goat show, with members from Texas and across the United States participating. The judge will be Bonnie Naumann.

Please return any of the entry forms that apply to you by **June 1, 2018**. **Remember that any goats selected for the sale must have the registration papers in order the day of the show.** You can pay for the show goats when you send in your entries, or you can pay on Friday. Entry fee is \$10.00 per head with 80% of the money returned to the top 5 goats in each class. **Note: Our sale will be offering white and colored angora goats with the same rules. Each breeder may sell up to 12 yearling does, 12 yearling bucks, 5 buck kids and 5 doe kids. You will need the papers for all sale goats.** The Annie Auld and Bob Davis Special Class will be judged Saturday, June 30th, at 11:00 a.m. Mr. Jad Davis will be the judge this year.

Gene Edmiston will be the auctioneer. We plan to have four boys lined up to help on the day of the sale. The sale will begin at 1:00 with the does.

In order to reward those breeders who have stayed in the Angora Goat business, the Davis family has created a special award for aged angora does age six (6) years and over and has generously included an award of \$1000.00 to be given to the first place aged doe.

Conditions:

1. The doe aged six years and over (**born 2012 or before**) must have at least four kids registered with the American Angora Goat Breeders Association. An entry form must be completed and postmarked to **Dale Naumann**, Secretary by **June 1, 2018**. On the entry form, the exhibitor will list the kids that have been registered with the AAGBA. These forms will be sent to the AAGBA for verification.
2. Exhibitors will be limited to two (2) entries in this class.
3. Exhibitor does not have to have raised the doe. Registrations papers must show that the exhibitor is the owner of the doe and the owner must have registered at least one (1) kid from this doe with the AAGBA in the name of the owner.
4. All rules for show goats for regular TAGRA show will apply.
5. Exhibitors must be members of the Texas Angora Goat Raisers' Association (TAGRA) and the American Angora Goat Breeders Association (AAGBA) by **June 1, 2018**.

The judge for the **2018** show will be **Jad Davis**. *The show will be on Saturday, June 30, 2018, 11:00 a.m.* Goats will be tied to the fence or held by other breeders while showing.

To be eligible for Premium Awards, the Angora must have been shorn on or after February 1 of the current year. A Certificate of Registration issued by the A.A.G.B.A. must be furnished if requested by the judge.

Show Buck Kids – less than one year:
80% of entry fees will be dispersed to the top five in each class.

Show Bucks – one year and less than two:
80% of entry fees will be dispersed to the top five in each class.

Show Bucks – two years and over:
80% of entry fees will be dispersed to the top five in each class.

Instructions for all participants

If you plan on showing goats at the ACAGR/TAGRA show or sell goats at the auction, you will need to be a TAGRA member. The fee for a one year membership is only \$15. You can complete the bottom of this page and mail it in with your entry form or you can pay at the show.

If you are bringing goats from states other than Texas you will need a health certificate from your veterinarian. Goats coming from within Texas are not required to have a health certificate. Here is a link to the official information for bringing goats into Texas:
